



UK-ETS Emissions Monitoring Plan (MP) Preparation and Submission Support Service

■ Service Overview

Under the UK Emissions Trading Scheme (UK-ETS), maritime operators are required to prepare an Emissions Monitoring Plan (MP) for each applicable vessel^(*) and submit it to the UK Regulator for approval.

MP preparation and submission are carried out through the UK-ETS emissions reporting system, "Manage your UK Emissions Trading Scheme" ("METS"). Based on the information and documents provided by the applicant, this service supports MP preparation on METS and initial submission to the UK Regulator.

(*) Vessels of 5,000 GT and above calling at ports under UK jurisdiction, regardless of flag state.

■ MP Submission Deadline to the UK Regulator

- On and after 1 July 2026, the MP must be submitted to the regulator within 42 days from the vessel's first call at a UK port. The applicant is responsible for managing the submission deadline.
- PTCS generally requires **5 business days**, including the applicant's confirmation process, after receiving all necessary information/documents and being added as a Consultant/Agent user on METS.

(*) Weekends, public holidays and PTCS holidays are not included in the above period. Applications submitted close to the deadline may not be completed by the requested date.

■ Scope of Service

- Preparation support for UK-ETS MPs using EU-MRV MP data available on THETIS-MRV
- MP data entry support on METS
- Support up to initial submission to the UK Regulator

■ Out of Scope

- Responses to UK Regulator comments, and MP correction/revision or resubmission
- Any guarantee of MP approval by the UK Regulator
- METS account opening service

■ Fees

- Basic fee: JPY 275,000 + JPY 22,000 per vessel (tax included)

Example:

For 10 vessels, JPY 275,000 + JPY 22,000 × 10 vessels = JPY 495,000 (tax included)

- The above fees do not include application fees payable to the UK Regulator or MOHA account opening fees.

■ Conditions for Using the Service

- The applicant must have obtained a METS account before applying for this service.
- The applicant must add PTCS as a Consultant/Agent user on METS.
- The applicant must cooperate with User account activation for PTCS's first METS login.
- The MP for each target vessel must be available on THETIS-MRV with MRV MP Status: Approved.
- The applicant must share the THETIS-MRV ID and password with PTCS as necessary.
- If the customer cancels after application, actual costs incurred may be charged.

■ Important Notes Regarding METS Login

- METS login requires two-factor authentication. The applicant must install an authentication app, such as Authenticator, on a smartphone or similar device in advance.
- For PTCS's first METS login as Consultant/Agent, a User account activation email will be sent to the applicant's registered email address. Please follow the email instructions and change PTCS's Account Status from "Accepted" to "Active".

Service Flow for UK-ETS MP Preparation and Submission Support Service

The roles and basic workflow between the applicant (maritime operator) and PTCS are shown below. The basic service covers up to completion of the initial MP submission on METS.

Step	Applicant	PTCS
1	Obtain a METS account and prepare the login environment (including Authenticator setup)	
2	Submit the application form and necessary documents to PTCS (EU-MRV MP information, target vessel information (including registered owner information), Company Registration Certificate (English translation separately required), THETIS-MRV login information, etc.)	
3		Review and accept the application and necessary documents
4	Add PTCS as Consultant/Agent to the applicant's METS account	
5		Start login operation to METS
6	Authenticate PTCS login via the User account activation email sent to the registered email address (real-time support required)	Confirm successful login and complete initial setup (subsequent logins can be performed without applicant confirmation)
7		Enter MP data on METS
8	Review the MP input data on METS, as necessary	Send confirmation request to the applicant
9		Initially submit the MP to the UK Regulator on METS
10		Send initial submission completion notice to the applicant
11		Issue invoice
12	Payment
